









The steepest part of Maximin Herrenberg is the origin of our Grosses Gewächs. In this parcel the slate is harder and scantier. Extreme conditions for Human and vine.

The iron content of the slate is so high, that it makes the slate colering red. 1902 this part of Maximin Herrenberg was planted. Those old, ungrafted vines are still standing today and give a great potential for this wine.

Very old ungrafted vines in the combination with the unique terroir create this this complex wine. Maximin Herrenberg GG always offers great intense ripe fruits.
