RITSCH GROSSES GEWÄCHS







Only classified terroir is allowed to be called Grosses Gewächs. We are proud to own soils which meet those high standards: Laurentiuslay, Ritsch and Maximin Herrenberg. Those vineyards are classified as Grosses Gewächs by the Bernkasteler Ring. The allowed yield is only at 50 hl/ha at the highest ripeness of the grapes.

The Ritsch offers ideal conditions for Grosses Gewächs. The concentration of ripeness, mineral aromas and playful elegance is extraordinary. It is important to me, that the wine keeps the elegant character of the Moselriesling despite of the enormous concentration of aromas.

The Ritsch is harvested at the very end of the vintage in order to ensure an ideal ripeness of the grapes.
