## Maximin Herrenberg Großes Gewächs



Grand Cru from the steepest and most demanding part of the vineyard

Our Großes Gewächs originates from the steepest and most rugged section of the Maximin Herrenberg. In this parcel, the slate is particularly hard and poor in nutrients—conditions that push both vine and grower to their limits.

The soil here is rich in iron, and due to oxidation, the slate takes on a distinctive red hue. This part of the Herrenberg was replanted in 1902, and remarkably, the ungrafted vines from that time have survived to this day. They form the basis of our finest dry Riesling.

These ancient vines, combined with the extreme terroir, yield a wine of striking depth and complexity. The Maximin Herrenberg Großes Gewächs is marked by ripe, seductive fruit, subtle minerality, and an elegant structure that reflects its origin with clarity.

Yields are naturally low, but the result is a wine of exceptional character—a powerful yet graceful expression of one of the Mosel's most storied vineyards.
